### **PROGRAMME OF THE TRAINING ACTIVITIES (DAY BY DAY)**

#### **9.4.2018 – Monday (1<sup>st</sup> day)**

Arrival. Students go to the families and teachers to their accommodations.

#### **10.4.2018 – Tuesday (2<sup>nd</sup> day)**
